CALL FOR PAPERS

The conference will focus on reflection and debate on the potential of information and communication in democratic governance, social responsibility, human rights, accountability and social change. Structured around four key questions: What is the role of government and the media?, Can be considered socially responsible?, Contribute or hinder the right to information, public debate and transparency?, Are the ICT and cultural spaces for the exercise of citizenship and participation?

The conference will be distributed in the morning and afternoon sessions, integrated with papers and communications according to the following thematic areas:

- Institutional communication with quality and democratic control.
- Communication for social change and social responsibility of the media.
- Information, Internet and citizen participation.
- Actions collaborative, technology and culture.

Information for contributors

It is opened the period to **present paper proposals until 15th October 2013 (EXTENDED DEADLINE).** Each proposal must contain the following information: title of the paper, abstract (5 to 10 lines of text), name of the author/s, address and contact email, profession or institution in which he/ she works. The proposals will be mailed to the following address: gruprecercacsii@udg.edu

A Scientific Committee will consider the proposals and report writing of their acceptance within a period of one month.

The texts of the papers will be delivered in digital format for publication in the term set by the Organizing Committee. Communications that meet the conditions required scientific rigor will be collected in a volume of the event. Each communication will have a maximum of 20 pages, double spaced, Arial 12 (including notes and bibliography). It will be informed with more details of the publication rules with the acceptance of the paper, which will notify each applicant by email.

Information for participants

The participants will receive a certificate of attendance that it will be controlled with a signatures system.
